PETITION OF DOUGLAS H. WATTS TO INTERVENE IN  
THE PUBLIC ADJUDICATORY HEARING ON THE  
PETITION TO MODIFY WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATIONS  
FILED BY DOUGLAS H. WATTS.

I, Douglas H. Watts, state as follows:

1. I am Douglas H. Watts. I live at 131 Cony Street, Augusta, Maine.
2. On Oct. 3, 2005 I filed with the Maine Board of Environmental Protection a petition ("Petition") with evidentiary appendices requesting modification of water quality certification orders issued by the State of Maine for the abovementioned hydroelectric dams on the Kennebec River, Maine.
3. My Oct. 3, 2005 petition requested the Maine BEP modify these certifications to require immediate installation and operation of safe and effective downstream passage facilities for native fish of the Kennebec River, including but not limited to Atlantic salmon, alewife, American shad, blueback herring and American eel.
4. On January 19, 2006 the Maine BEP voted to schedule a public adjudicatory hearing on my Petition dated October 3, 2005.
5. Department Rules state that "any person" may file a Petition requesting modification of water quality certification orders. I meet the statutory definition of "any person." I am the same person who wrote and submitted the Oct. 3, 2005 Petition bearing my name. Unless evidence exists to show that I am not me, there can be no question as to my status as a full party and participant in a public adjudicatory hearing on my OWN Petition.
