

Report on 2017 Archaeological Excavations At Thwings Point, Woolwich, Maine

Introduction

On July 17, 2017, archaeologists and volunteers returned to Thwings Point in Woolwich, Maine to continue archaeological excavations on 17th and 18th -century house sites. The two week (10 day) excavation and field school was sponsored by Claire and Michael Robinson, and the Friends of Merrymeeting Bay (FOMB). Previous work on this site in 2009, 2011, 2014 and 2015 uncovered evidence of occupation from the third quarter 17th century home of Thomas Ashley, the c. 1720 house built by Edward Hutchinson, and the mid-18th century home of Nathaniel Thwing. The general location was first identified during a 2007 reconnaissance level archaeological survey funded by a grant from FOMB and the Land For Maine's Future Board. The 2009 excavation narrowed the location of occupation by uncovering four features, all probable post holes, and artifacts ranging from the 17th century through the mid-19th century. The 2011 excavation located two cellar holes as well as a wealth of artifacts relating to the various occupations. The 2014 excavation determined the approximate size of one of the cellar holes (Feature 6), found three sides of the second cellar hole (Feature 5), and was able to identify which cellar belonged to which period of occupation. Results of the 2015 excavation determined that the approximate inside dimensions of the Feature 5 cellar hole were 19' 3" x 16' 8". Additional work on the southeast wall of Feature 5 found that there was a jog in the cellar wall. Research after the 2015 report was completed found this architectural feature is probably a "Beverly jog." Found almost exclusively on the north shore of Boston a "Beverly Jog" is an addition added to Georgian style homes in the late 1700s. The jog originated in the Essex county town of Beverly, Massachusetts, hence the name. Typically, the jog is added to one side of the back of the house. The narrow addition juts out from the side of the house allowing for a door, staircase and/or a window on the second and third floors. The door often leads straight into the kitchen. (See Figure 2, F5.)

Goals for the 2017 field season included determining how the cellar walls of Feature 6 were constructed. The most probable answer was that they were wooden walls, but we had yet to find proof of this. Also we were looking for evidence of the structure that surrounded the Feature 6 cellar hole. At Feature 5 we wanted to determine a more exact measurement of the inside dimensions of the cellar hole.




Figure 1. Project area shown on Richmond USGS quad.

Methodology

A series of standardized field and laboratory procedures were utilized for Phase II testing at Thwings Point. The first step prior to excavation was to re-establish the metric grid that had been superimposed over the site in 2009. Subsurface testing was accomplished with the excavation of 1m² test units called test pits (TPs) aligned with the metric grid. Grid coordinates were written on flagging tape. Test pits are designated by the grid designation at the southwest corner of each test pit. Most initial excavation was done with sharpened shovels, and then trowels were used where appropriate. Excavations were done in arbitrary, natural, or man-made soil levels. By natural levels we mean soil horizons and unmodified flood deposits. Man-made soil levels are present where human disturbance has artificially created soil changes. Arbitrary levels are usually 10 - 20 cm thick. All soils were screened through 1/4" mesh hardware cloth to ensure the recovery of small artifacts. All soils were sifted onto tarps to facilitate backfilling the test pits and to leave less obvious ground disturbance. Profiles or floor plans of test units were drawn where needed. Digital color photographs were taken where relevant. Artifacts were bagged and taken to the Maine Historic Preservation Commission (MHPC) Archaeology Lab in Augusta where they were washed and dried by provenience unit. They were then taken to Cranmer's home where they were sorted, identified, counted, and entered into a relational database using a cataloging program written in Access, then analyzed. The Robinsons, landowners of the site and thus of the artifacts, have agreed to transfer custody of the artifacts to Old Fort Western, Augusta, Maine. There they will be housed, curated and made available to researchers.




Figure 2. Plan of excavations to date.

Fieldwork

A total of 15.25 square meters was excavated during the 2017 field season. Please refer to Figure 2 which shows those test units excavated this year (in red) and for the following discussion.

The first area we began work on was around Feature 6, the 17th-century cellar hole. We wanted to determine how the cellar was constructed. At this point the best theory was that it was wood-lined but there was yet no evidence for this. To try to answer this question, three 1x1 m test pits were excavated at N203 E190, N205 E189 and N207 E191. N207 E191 was excavated to a maximum depth of 144 cm b.d. (below datum). On the floor of the test pit a row of rock was found along the west wall (Figure 4). The rock shown in Figure 4 along the north wall was well above the floor of the test unit, thus not necessarily associated with the rock on the floor along the west wall. With a good imagination one could suggest that the rock along the west wall somewhat aligns with the northeast line of the cellar. There was no other evidence in this unit of wood lining or any other type of demarcation between the builder's trench for the cellar and the cellar itself.

The test unit at N203 E190 was also excavated to a depth of 144 cm b.d. (Figure 5). Again we found no evidence of wood lining for the cellar or any type of line dividing the builder's trench from the actual cellar. The only thing found here of possible interest to our search was the square rock sticking out of the north wall and above the floor. As can be seen in Figure 5, there was brick below the rock. But, again, with imagination, the square rock could be seen to align with the south corner of the cellar excavation.




Figure 8. Profile of the north wall of N205 E189 showing rock wall and probable builder’s trench noted. It can be seen that the rock wall was build against the wall of the builder’s trench.

The last pit excavated to try and determine how the Feature 6 cellar was constructed proved much more informative than the previous two. The test pit at N205 E189 was excavated to a maximum of 137 cm b.d. (Figure 7). Beginning at about 79 cm b.d. a stone wall began to appear in the northeast corner of the square. As can be seen from the profile of the north wall (Figure 8), there is no doubt that this is a wall. Also in the profile can be seen the probable line of the builder's trench (the original hole dug for the cellar). This wall aligns with the southwest wall of the Feature 6 cellar builder's trench. Considering this, the suggestion that the rocks identified in the previous two test units might be part of a cellar wall

cannot necessarily be dismissed as wishful thinking. However, the probability that this was a stone-lined cellar results in a very small cellar, perhaps 5' x 8', making it a small cold cellar. This will be discussed further.




Figure 9. Plan showing Feature 9 in N211 E194 HPW along with a flat rock in N211 E193.

Another question regarding Feature 6 concerned the building surrounding the cellar. We had found evidence of possible post holes, four in 2009 and one in 2015, but none of these features were “text book” examples of post holes. The most likely “post hole” we had to work with was the last found, Feature 8. It was closest to the Feature 6 builder’s trench, and, except for being relatively shallow, looked promising. We extended a line parallel with the northwest line of Feature 6, northeast from Feature 8, and excavated a test pit at N210 E191. This test unit proved negative for features so we moved to the next 1x1 m unit at N210 E192 HPN (half pit

north) and N211E192 HPS (half pit south). This pit also was negative for features, so again, we moved to the northeast to N211 E193. Here, in the middle of the east wall a relatively large flat rock was found with two smaller rocks below it. The adjoining half pit to the east at N211 E194 was opened. Here we found another possible post hole associated with the flat rock previously found (Figure 9). Again the feature was shallow, very much like Feature 8. This feature was

designated Feature 9. Most promising about this find was that Feature 9 was about 16.5' from Feature 8 which is a rod, a common unit of measurement at the time. We now had a distance and direction to work with.

While the above pits were being excavated a test unit to the southwest of Feature 8 at N207 E187 was started, looking for post holes in this direction. Here we found nothing resembling a post hole. After the discovery of Feature 9, a 1x1m. unit was opened at N205 E185 HPN and N206 E185 HPS, one rod southwest of Feature 8. Here we found a rock (Figure 10). There was no indication of a post hole, but, there were rocks in Features 8 and 9, this rock was one rod from Feature 8, and it forms a straight line with Features 8 and 9. The rock was therefore designated Feature 10.

Excavations couldn't extend another rod to the southwest from Feature 10 because of Feature 5. Work couldn't extend a rod northeast from Feature 9 because of poison ivy.

Therefore, the next approach was to make a 90⁰ turn to the southeast from Feature 10, extend the line one rod and excavate there, at N201 E188, assuming Feature 10 might have been a corner of the structure. The only features uncovered here were plow scars. Following the same line from Feature 10 and also a southwest line from Feature 3 (assuming Feature 3 might be a structural post hole corresponding with Feature 8 on the opposite side of the cellar) N199 E189 was opened, with equally negative results. Following that same southwest line from Feature 3 and extending it 2 rods, we opened a test unit at N194 E184, again with negative results.

Work on trying to determine the inside measurements of the Feature 5 cellar began with opening a test pit at N200 E177 (Figure 11).

At 83 cm. b.d. a large flat stone was encountered which proved to be the remains of the foundation wall of the Feature 5 cellar. The adjoining half pit to the north, N201 E177 HPS was opened to further follow the




Figure 12. N200/01 E177 completed to 118 cm. B.d. showing the southwest cellar wall.

the wall and allow more room to excavate the wall (Figure 12). The cellar floor was reached at 118 cm. b.d.

After completing work on the southwest wall, excavation moved to the opposite cellar wall, the northeast wall where a test pit was opened at N205 E180. Unfortunately, the only structural remains found here were jumbled rocks. The adjoining quad, N205 E179 SEQ (south east quad) was opened to determine if some of these rocks were part of a wall, but the results were negative. Apparently the cellar wall at this point had been completely destroyed.

On the last day of the dig a test pit was opened at N203 E176 to try and find the inner edge of the northwest cellar wall. Time ran out and the depth of this unit only reached 53 cm. b.d.

Artifacts




Figure 13. Example of nails showing hand-forged nails at top and three cut nails and a wire nail (far right) at bottom. (After Noël Hume 1969: 253.)

A total of 5508 individual artifacts were recovered during the 2017 field season. The most common artifact type found was 2023 nails and spikes which made up 37% of the total number of artifacts. Adding to the nail count 421 fragments of brick, 405 shards of window glass, 36 possible pieces of daub and 12 pieces of shingle, results in 2897 architectural artifacts, or 53% of the total number of artifacts found. The nail assemblage consisted of 896 cut nails, 332 hand-forged nails, 733 indeterminate square nails (i.e. hand-forged or cut) and 18 wire nails (Figure 13), along with 44 spikes (1 hand-forged, 2 indeterminate and the rest cut). Brick was found in

every test unit. The 421 fragments of brick recovered represents only a small portion of the brick found since only a small representative sample was kept during excavation.

Thirty six possible pieces of daub were found this year (Figure 14). Daub is a medieval building material consisting of a mixture of clay, straw and occasionally other ingredients such as manure, used as in-fill between woven sticks, called wattle, and used to form a wall. Wattle and

daub construction was also used for chimneys, and daub alone could be used as chinking between the logs of a log structure. This building technique was brought to America from Europe and used throughout the 17th and early 18th centuries by the earliest settlers to an area. Once sawmills were established, wattle and daub structures would be replaced or at least covered over with wood. When a wattle and daub structure burned, the daub would be fired and the end result resembles brick. It is sometimes difficult to distinguish between the two, especially when they are as small as the pieces pictured in Figure 14. What could be significant about the daub found this season is that 32 of the 36 pieces found all came from the same general area, N210/211 E191/192; the pits excavated in search of Feature 9, along the “wall” between Features 8 & 9.

Ceramics, with 1903 shards recovered, were the second most common artifact type found, with redwares comprising 39% of this assemblage. Redware, as the name implies, is a red-bodied utilitarian ware which in most cases is non-diagnostic, found on American sites from the earliest settlement to the present. During past excavations here, large pieces of redware which cross-mended to reconstruct vessels were found, but this year that was not the case. Two of the largest cross-mended pieces found are shown in Figure 15. At left is part of a bowl and at right is a milk

pan. At center is a piece with two holes, and a third hole barely visible along the right edge. One possibility is that this piece was part of a colander.

The second most common ceramic type found was pearlware, consisting of 737 shards representing 16 different styles of pearlware. Pearlware, an English refined earthenware, was first introduced about 1775, and produced in some forms until the mid-19th century (Figure 16).

Closely related to pearlware (developmentally) is creamware which, with 298 shards, was the third most common ceramic found. Creamware is an English refined earthenware manufactured from 1762 to about 1820, and was the predecessor of pearlware. In addition to the three ceramic types mentioned, the excavation also found 10 other ceramic types. A sample of some of these types along with creamware are shown in Figure 17. From top left: English white

salt-glaze stoneware (n=12) is a refined stoneware which dates from 1720 to 1805. English brown stoneware (n=6) dates from 1690 to 1775. The Iberian oil jar (n=1) was used for olives, olive oil, and reused for storage. They range in date from the 16th well into the 18th century. Westerwald (n=2) with cobalt or manganese infill, and with its incised or stamped floral or geometric designs and/or sprig molded medallions, dates from about 1690 to 1775. Tin-glaze, or delftware, (n=77) is a soft, buff-to-pink-bodied, fine earthenware, with a thick enameled glaze or lead glaze made opaque with tin, manufactured from the 16th century into the early 19th century. (The number of pieces of 77 can be misleading. The glaze easily pops off in the ground and this number includes just glaze and pieces of paste without glaze.) Jackfield is a red-bodied earthenware that is often fired so high it can be considered a stoneware. Covered with a black lead glaze it dates from 1740 to 1790. Nottingham is an English stoneware often with a thin white slip covered by a brown, almost metallic glaze, and dates from 1700 to 1810.

Bottles and glass tableware are included along with ceramics in the category of food preparation, service and storage. A total of 127 shards of bottle glass were found and the two most informative pieces are shown in Figure 18. Both pieces are wine bottle bases with the larger piece on the left from Feature 5 cellar hole and the fragment on the right from Feature 6. The kick-up or push-up in the base was made with a bare metal pontil, a method used world-wide between 1830 and 1860. A total of 12 shards of tableware glass were found this year.

Figure 19 shows the four pieces which are diagnostic. The top three shards are wheel-engraved. Although wheel-engraving had been used for some time, copper-wheel engraving was perfected in England around 1725. Most wheel-engraved pieces found on American sites date to 1780 - 1820. Below in Figure 19 is a portion of a folded foot ring from a wine type glass. The brown or discolored portion of this piece is the result of soil trapped within the fold. Folded foot rings are not especially datable, being popular from the 17th century to the mid-18th century.

A final group of artifacts in the food preparation, serving and storage category are bones. This year we did not find the quantity or variety of bone as in past excavations. No fish bone was found, only 1 unidentified bird bone, and 2 pieces of shell. A total of 327 mammal bones were recovered. Everything identifiable was from domestic animals, cow, pig and sheep/goat.

The next artifact category to be discussed is personal items, beginning with clay tobacco pipes. The clay tobacco pipe is one of the most useful artifacts for the archaeologist, and one of the most numerous found on colonial American sites. The bore or hole diameter in the stem of a clay tobacco pipe is one of its more diagnostic characteristics and can be used to provide a mean date for the pipe's manufacture. From the introduction of the pipe in the 1570s up until the 1750s, the bore in the stem of the pipe decreased in diameter at a regular rate. The bore sizes generally range from $\frac{9}{64}$ " for the earlier pipes to $\frac{4}{64}$ " for 19th and 20th-century pipes. The pipe bowl is also diagnostic in that its size, shape, and decoration changed over time.

A total of 64 clay tobacco pipe fragments were found this season (Figure 20).

Again this year we found red clay tobacco pipe fragments, but fewer than in previous years. Red pipe fragments found consist of 1 stem and 4 bowl fragments. Red clay pipes are not extremely common in Maine because their peak of popularity appears to have been the fourth quarter of the 17th century. This was a time when most of Maine was devoid of English settlers because of a series of wars with the Native Americans. However, a few red clay pipes are found on sites dating to the late third quarter of the 17th century. It is not known where these pipes were made, but some research suggests the Boston area.

The white clay pipe fragments consisted of 16 bowl fragments and 43 stems. The pipe stem bore diameter measurements were as follows: $4\frac{4}{64}$ " , $5\frac{5}{64}$ " , $4\frac{6}{64}$ " , $8\frac{7}{64}$ " , $8\frac{8}{64}$ " and $5\frac{9}{64}$ ". We have a heavier concentration of 17th-century pipes this year compared to other years, perhaps because we spent more time working around the 17th-century cellar, Feature 6. The two larger bowl fragments shown in Figure 20 were the largest bowl fragments found this year. At left in the photo are two of the 5 red pipe fragments found.

Other personal items include the three buttons and one buckle shown in Figure 21. The partial button at top left is three pieces cross-mended and is the front of what is left of a two-piece brass button. The front had been stamped with a design which can no longer be identified. The two remaining buttons are made of a type of brass called tombac which is a copper/zinc alloy. This common button type was most popular during the mid to late 18th century.

The smaller button was probably used for a waistcoat or sleeve while the larger button would have been used on a coat. The buckle at the bottom of Figure 21 is of a simple loop style probably used for personal dress. This piece has been conserved.

Only one coin was found this year (shown in Figure 22 at top) but it is an unusual one. This is a post colonial coin made for New Jersey in 1786. After the

Revolution and before the United States started minting its own coins in 1792, states petitioned the government to make their own money. At bottom in Figure 22 is an example of this New Jersey issue in good condition.

The final artifacts to be discussed under the category of personal items are related to sewing shown in Figure 23. The thimble at bottom is the third thimble found on site, and by far the smallest. It is slightly bent at the bottom so a measure of the inside diameter could not be made, but young girls were taught to sew as early as five years old and this thimble could certainly have fit such a young child. The scissors shown in the center of Figure 23 are identical to ones shown in Mary Beaudry's book on the archaeology of sewing (2006: 127) and identified as "eighteenth-century English sewing scissors." This pair of scissors has been conserved. The single blade at top may be shears as opposed to scissors, but a definite identification has not been confirmed.

The final artifact to be considered is not related to either the 17th or 18th -century occupation of the site but rather the late 19th early 20th -century ice houses that occupied the property. Figure 24 shows the working end or head of a pick pole. Such poles were used to

maneuver blocks of ice in the river, onto the conveyer belt to the ice house, and inside the ice house. The excavator of the piece, Ellen Batutis, is show with her discovery, and Figure 26 shows Nathan Lipfert with a complete pick pole he owns.

Conclusions

The 2017 field season at Thwings Point can be considered moderately successful in that we fulfilled most of our goals, but in a round-about way. One goal was to determine how the Feature 6 cellar was constructed, starting with the assumption that it was wood lined. However, based on questionable evidence it appears to have been stone-lined. The evidence is questionable because one test pit (N203 E190) contained one large squared rock which could form one of the corners of the cellar. Another pit (N207 E191) contained a vague row of rock which could line up with a cellar wall. However, what saved the whole theory of a stone-lined cellar was found in N205 E189 where an actual rock wall was unearthed which aligned with the cellar hole. This leaves a fairly small cellar, perhaps 5' x 8', but that is not necessarily too small for a 17th-century cold cellar. The cellar at Cushnoc, a Plymouth colony trading post built in 1628 (in present day Augusta), measured 7' square. The cellar at the Nahumkeag trading post built c. 1650 (in present day Pittston) was long but only about 4' wide.

Another goal was to find the outline of the building which sat over the Feature 6 cellar. We began with Feature 8, a probable post hole off the northwest wall of Feature 6. We found another possible post hole (Feature 9) 16.5' or 1 rod from Feature 8 along a line parallel with the cellar wall. Going 16.5' in the other direction from Feature 8 we found a rock in N205/206 E185. Not very convincing, but Features 8 and 9 both contained rocks so this new rock was designated Feature 10. What strengthens the argument that this line of three features is part of a wall is that a concentration of daub was found along this line between Features 8 and 9 – perhaps the remains of a smoke hood? Search for additional post holes was unsuccessful.

A third and final goal was to get a good measurement of the inside diameter of the Feature 5 cellar. In N200/201 E177 a good section of the southwest wall of the cellar was found. But moving to the opposite northeast wall, we found that this wall had been completely destroyed. However, from the section of wall found it was determined that the inside of the wall was approximately 80 cm. (2' 7") from the upper edge of the builder's trench. This measurement was also found at another section of the cellar wall in 2015 and it was determined that if this measurement held true all around the cellar, the inside dimension of the cellar would be approximately 19' 3" x 16' 8". So we can conclude that this is roughly the cellar measurement.

Further research on the site might elicit additional questions, but at this time the only outstanding question to be answered concerns the size and shape of the structure related to the Feature 6 cellar hole. Another field season at the site might concentrate on identifying this structure, but considering the questionable nature of the possible post holes thus far identified, the unfortunate location of trees, and the proximity of the Feature 5 structure, this task might prove frustrating. Perhaps future work at the site might wait until more questions arise.
